

1.2. INTRODUCTION

DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH & PREVENTIVE MEDICINE

The Directorate of Public Health and Preventive Medicine was formed during 1923 in Tamilnadu with the main objectives of provision of maternal and child health care to the rural and urban people and for prevention and control of communicable diseases. Lieut.Col.A.T.H. Russell was the First Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine in the Pre-independent era.

Public Health Act. 1939 is the legal instrument enacted before independence of the country which empowers the Health Officers to enforce Public Health Law to safeguard the Health of the people.

In 1966, the Department of Health Services and Family Planning was a unified integrated Department with Medical Services. Medical Education Directorate was formed after separating it from Department of Medical Services.

In 1976, the integrated Department was again divided into the Department of Public Health and Preventive Medicine(DPH&PM), Department of Medical services(DMS) and Department of Family Welfare(DFW).

The Drugs Control administration which continued under the Department of Public Health was separated in 1981 to form a separated Directorate.

In 1980, the Directorate of Primary Health Centres was formed exclusively for PHCs and in 1996 it was again brought under the control of Directorate of Public Health and Preventive Medicine.

The State Health Transport Department, which was with the Public Health Department, was separated from the Directorate of Public Health and Preventive Medicine on 15.07.1981

So there are continuous process of integration and separation in the department which had advantages and disadvantages in the department.

The Directorate of Public Health Training and Continuing Education was formed during 1988 by separating the Training component of Public and it was again merged during 1991.

As per the re-organization of the Department during 1980-81, there were seven regions, each region was administered by a Regional Assistant Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine with jurisdiction over two to three Revenue Districts. There were 29 Health Unit Districts. Each Health Unit District was headed by a District Health Officer. This system functioned well with decentralization of powers. Later, for financial austerity, these regional units have been closed and again the routine system of State and District Health Administration was formed during 1990.

Now, under the Directorate of Public Health and Preventive Medicine, 42 Health Unit Districts are functioning. Each Health Unit District is functioning under the technical and administrative control of one Deputy Director of Health Services. Each Health unit District comprises of 30-40 Primary Health Centres on an


average. The PHCs have been established at the rate of one per 30,000 rural population in plain areas and one per 20,000 rural population in hilly areas. Each Primary Health Centre is functioning under two or more Medical Officers with the support of a team of office and field health staff. Each Primary Health Centre comprises of 6 Health Sub-Centres on an average. These have been established at the rate of one per 5000 rural population in plain areas and one per 3000 rural population in hilly areas. All the National and State Health Programmes are being implemented successfully through these Primary Health Centres and Health Sub Centres.




1.3.1. ORGANISATION STRUCTURE OF HEALTH DEPARTMENT-TAMILNADU




1.3.2. ORGANISATION STRUCTURE OF DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH & PREVENTIVE MEDICINE



1.3.3. ORGANISATION STRUCTURE OF DIRECTORATE OF PUBLIC HEALTH & PREVENTIVE MEDICINE







1901 TO 2001**




