

8. SCHOOL HEALTH PROGRAMME-2008-09

SCHOOL HEALTH

The School Health Programme is implemented in this state with the objective of providing comprehensive health care services to all students studying in Government and Government aided schools from I to XII standards.

Every Thursday is a School Health day and every Saturday is a referral day in Tamilnadu.

A team of Medical Officer (PHC) and field health staff visit a school on Thursday with prior intimation and carry out all the Public health activities. The childhood diseases which may lead to serious illnesses are detected early by the team and treated in school itself. The students who require specialized treatment are referred to higher medical institutions and followed up subsequently for compliance status. The team provides health care services to the students thrice a year. In addition, 40 School Medical Inspection teams are functioning in selected Municipalities covering exclusively the urban areas. They visit the schools in their areas daily and carry out the public health activities.

The Medicines worth of Rs.300 lakhs are supplied to all the districts through TNMSC Ltd. annually for treatment and referral under this scheme.

- ❖ *2,09,811 School students are examined on every Thursday*

- ❖ *Among them, 610 students are referred to HMIs for higher treatment on every Thursday*
- ❖ *175 students are examined during every visit to the School*
- ❖ *Among them, 84 students are treated*
- ❖ *1 student is referred for HMIs from every 2 visits*

School Medical Inspection

School Medical Inspection teams are functioning in 40 selected Municipalities in Tamilnadu. This team comprises of one School Medical Officer, two Sector Health Nurses and one Office Assistant. This team visits schools in Municipal area daily to carry out the activities under School Health Programme. Annual Drug allocation is provided to this team by this Directorate and distributed through TNMSC. This team is functioning under the technical control of Municipal Health Officer/Deputy Director of Health Services.

PALLI SIRAR IRUDHAYA PADUKAPPU THITTAM

Introduction

A special programme of Screening for Heart Diseases among School Children and subjecting them for Free Heart Surgery was announced by Hon'ble Minister for Health on 24/4/2008 and it was inaugurated on 3/6/2008, the 85th birthday of Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamilnadu.

As per G.O.Ms.No.157 Health and Family Welfare (T3) Department Dated 29.5.2008, District Committees under the Chairmanship of District Collector with Dean, Joint Director of Health Services, Deputy Director of Health Services, Professor of Cardiology and Professor of Medicine have been formed in all districts to organise the Camp and conduct the programme.

Importance of this programme

Physical, mental and social well being is necessary for a child to express his / her maximum potential. Physical illness can be a hurdle in a child's life. School children Heart Surgery Programme is of immense value in this context.

In Government Hospitals, there is a long waiting list of the patients who require cardiac surgery. So the Government have decided to refer some of these poor cardiac patients, whose Parent / Guardian's Annual Income is less than Rs.50,000 to the Private Hospitals for performing investigation and surgery.

Memorandum of Understanding has already been signed with the 25 Private Hospitals under Palli Sirar Irudhaya Padukappu Thittam.

The students with Heart diseases are subjected to undergo Heart surgery under 3 categories according to the nature of their problem

The amount is being released by the Mission Director, State Health Society to the District Health Society. So far Rs. 10 crores have been released.

The prevalence of myopia short sightedness is increasing among the children. The uncorrected refractive errors affecting children are the main cause of vision impairment. This may result in educational backwardness, lower productivity and impaired quality of life. The correction of refractive errors with spectacles is the simplest, cheapest and most widely used method for improving the vision.



1. This programme has been launched as per the announcement made in the Assembly Budget Session 2009-2010 by the Hon'ble Minister for Health.
2. This programme commenced on 03.06.09, the 86th Birthday of Hon'ble Chief Minister as per the announcement.
3. Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister inaugurated this programme on 05.06.2009 at Secretariat providing spectacles to the needy students.
4. Students studying in 6th, 7th, 8th standard at Government Schools and Government aided schools will be screened for refractive errors and will be provided spectacles to those with defective vision.
5. Budget Estimate for this programme is Rs.5.38 crores.
6. One Teacher per School is trained by PHC Medical Officer / Para Medical Ophthalmic Assistant to screen school children.
7. Trained Teachers screen the school children studying VI to VIII standard and identify children with defective vision.
8. Para Medical Ophthalmic Assistant in turn examine the children with defective vision, assess the degree of refractive errors and issue prescription for spectacles.

9. Urban areas are allotted to willing NGOs engaged in Blindness Control Programme.
10. At district level, a District Co-ordination Committee chaired by District Collector with members from health, Education, Municipal and Local Administration and NGOs engaged in Blindness Control Co-ordinate and implement this programme.

So far 1,59,078 students have been identified for defective vision and 92,239 spectacles have been distributed to the students.

NATIONAL IODINE DEFICIENCY DISORDERS CONTROL PROGRAMME

The National Iodine Deficiency Disorders Control Programme was implemented in this state during 1991 and the State Iodine Deficiency Disorders Control Cell has been started functioning from 01.07.1994 onwards. The objective of the Programme is to identify the areas with Iodine Deficiency Disorders and take control measures through dietary supplementation of iodised salt through IEC activities. The Advocacy Programmes were conducted to the officers of Public Health, Education, Municipal administration and Civil Supplies for the effective implementation of the Programme. The Goitre Surveys conducted in all districts have established that the the iodine deficiency disorders are prevalent in all the districts.

A notification under the PFA Act has been issued banning the sale of non iodised salt for edible purpose. Spot testing of the salt samples are being done to assess the presence of iodine and know the availability and use of iodised salt for creating awareness among the salt producers, wholesalers, retailers and general public on the use of iodised salt. Also, non-statutory salt samples are lifted and sent to Food Analysis Laboratories for analysis to know the iodine content in salt.

- ❖ *During 2008-09, 1,31,636 no. of non-statutory salt samples were lifted and analysed. The result shows 11% samples confirmed NIL iodine, 31% confirmed less than required 15 ppm iodine and only 58% confirmed more than 15 ppm iodine.*
- ❖ *An average of 360 Salt samples are collected from shops and tested daily to check the presence of iodine. 208 Salt samples confirm the presence of required iodine level.*
