Sub: Tamil Nadu Medical Services – Promotion Counselling for
the post of Associate Professors –request for considering
the deputation period – Certain instructions – issued.

During the recent promotion counseling held on 23rd and 24th May 2009 for the post of Associate Professors in various specialities, the deputation orders issued by the Deans and Heads of Institutions have been considered as teaching period and based on that deputation orders, Medical Officers were permitted to take up promotion as Associate Professors in their respective specialities. In future such deputations will not be entertained and will be summarily rejected if any appeal made.

Further, it is informed that the Deans and Heads of Institutions are requested **not to depute** any Medical Officer from the originally posted Department to any other Department either in the College or in the Hospital. If any situation warrants the Deans and Heads of Institutions may address for permission to draft the services of the Medical Officers with proper justification. After careful examination and assessing the need for such deputation, the Director of Medical Education will grant permission which can be entered into the Service Register and incorporated in the service particulars for calculating teaching experience. **To recap it is informed that unless the Director of Medical Education issues deputation order it is not valid for any purpose in service matters.**
