ORDER:

The Director of Medical Education in the letter read has submitted proposals regarding designating the Medical Officers as Tutor, Assistant Professor, Professor etc., when they are appointed as teaching faculty in Medical Colleges to suit the norms of Medical Council of India. She has stated that the existing nomenclature of various posts in teaching side in the Medical Colleges are as follows:-

TUTOR / ASSISTANT PROFESSOR

1. Tutor / Assistant Professor - Non-Clinical Departments.
2. Tutor / Assistant Professor - Clinical Side.
3. Assistant Professor / Assistant Surgeon., Assistant Professor / Senior Assistant Surgeon and Assistant Professor / Civil Surgeon.

READER:

Reader – Redesignated as per G.O. (Ms) No. 33, Health and Family Welfare Department, dated: 2.2.2007 as Associate Professor (Senior Civil Surgeon) for which promotion orders are issued by the Government.

PROFESSOR

Professor – Consequent on joining as Reader counting the Teaching Experience period during the Assistant Professorship and Reader of 8 years he / she is re-designated as Professor both in Clinical and Non- Clinical side.

2. The Director of Medical Education has also stated that during the last inspection of Medical Council of India teams in some Medical Colleges, the Medical Council of India team has suggested to redesignate the faculty as per the Medical Council of India norms so as to give permission to admit the students in the said Medical Colleges. The Director of Medical Education has therefore requested the Government to issue instructions for redesignating the Medical Officers as Tutor, Senior Residents, Assistant Professor, Associate Professor, Professor etc., when they are posted as teaching faculty to suit the norms of Medical Council of India. Further the Director of Medical Education has stated that by implementing the above proposal, there will not be any extra expenditure to the Government by way of increment, additional allowance or perks. The duration of service and designation will fulfill the Medical Council of India norms and in future all the orders issued by her Directorate and Government will be on par with the Directorates of Medical Education in other States in India.

3. The Government have examined the proposal of the Director of Medical Education and issue instruction to redesignate the Medical Officer as Tutor, Assistant Surgeon, Professor etc., when they are posted as teaching faculty in Government Medical Colleges to suit the MCI Norms as follows, subject to the condition that there should be no extra expenditure to the Government.

- (i) The Medical Officers appointed by the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine when they are released to Director of Medical Education side for posting in teaching side shall be designated as Tutor in the Non-Clinical side and Senior Resident in the Clinical side irrespective of their qualification in the scale of pay of Rs. 8000-275- 13,500.
- (ii) On completion of one year teaching experience as Tutor or Senior Resident in the Speciality concerned, they shall be designated and appointed as Assistant Professor, if they are qualified with Post Graduate degree as per the Medical Council of India norms by the Dean of the institution concerned.
- (iii) The Assistant Professors of both Clinical and Non-Clinical shall be promoted as Associate Professors on completion of 5 years of Teaching Experience in the Speciality concerned depending on the vacancy and by drawing up a panel in the scale of pay of Rs. 12,000-375-16,500.
- (iv) The Associate Professors who are promoted from the cadre of Assistant Professors shall be designated and appointed as Professor on completion of 4 years of teaching experience as Associate professor by the Director of Medical Education in the scale of pay of Rs. 12000- 375-16500.

- (v) Regarding super-speciality Departments, the Medical Officers shall be designated and appointed as Assistant Professors from the post of Senior Resident on completion of three years of Teaching experience with Super Speciality qualification in the Speciality concerned. There should be a sanctioned / organized Department with a Head of the Department with other infrastructure facilities to name it as "Department" of the College and Hospital. On completion of two years of teaching experience as Assistant Professor, they should be promoted as Associate Professor depending on the vacancy by drawing up a panel by the Government. Further, on completion of 4 years of teaching experience as Associate professor, they should be promoted and appointed as Professor.

The following amendment is issued to G.O.(Ms) No. 13, Health and Family Welfare Department, dated: 11.1.2008:-

AMENDMENT

For the existing Para 3 (ii), the following shall be substituted.

- a. Those who are qualified with 3 years Post Graduate Degree as per Medical Council of India Norms and working as Tutor / Resident in the Speciality concerned shall be designated as Assistant Professor from the date of passing the qualifying examinations by the concerned Dean of the Institution.
- b. In case of Medical Officers who have acquired Master Degree at a later date after joining as Tutor / Resident, re-designation and appointment will be done from the date of passing the Post Graduate Degree.

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c. If the Post Graduate period is two years only, then they should do one year as Tutor / Resident in the concerned speciality after acquiring Post Graduate Degree except those who have done two years of Diploma in the concerned speciality in addition to Post Graduate Degree as service candidate for re-designation as Assistant Professor.
